- 2 O my God, in you I trust; do not let me be put to shame; do not let my enemies exult over me.
- 3 Do not let those who wait for you be put to shame; let them be ashamed who are wantonly treacherous.
- 4 Make me to know your ways, O Lord; teach me your paths.
- 5 Lead me in your truth, and teach me, for you are the God of my salvation; for you I wait all day long.
- 6 Be mindful of your mercy, O Lord, and of your steadfast love, for they have been from of old.
- 7 Do not remember the sins of my youth or my transgressions; according to your steadfast love remember me, for your goodness' sake, O Lord!
- 8 Good and upright is the Lord; therefore he instructs sinners in the way.
- 9 He leads the humble in what is right, and teaches the humble his way.
- 10 All the paths of the Lord are steadfast love and faithfulness, for those who keep his covenant and his decrees.

Natural	[implied] receptivity	Receptor cells in the body that receive and identify specific proteins and marker molecules, then respond by performing a predetermined task in the cell. They won't work without the right protein and won't accept the wrong protein.	Use a jigsaw puzzle, maybe a child's one with really big pieces, to demonstrate the way receptor cells and proteins fit together. This is how the Psalmist wants to be with God's instruction.
