

Galatians 2:15-21 New Revised Standard Version (NRSV)

15 We ourselves are Jews by birth and not Gentile sinners;

16 yet we know that a person is justified [**CLAP!**]

not by the works of the law [**SNAP!**]

but through faith [**A-MEN!**]

in Jesus Christ [**YES-LORD!**].

And we have come to believe in Christ Jesus [**YES-LORD!**],

so that we might be justified [**CLAP!**]

by faith [**A-MEN!**]

in Christ [**YES-LORD!**],

and not by doing the works of the law [**SNAP!**],

because no one will be justified [**CLAP!**]

by the works of the law [**SNAP!**].

17 But if, in our effort to be justified [**CLAP!**]

in Christ [**YES-LORD!**],

we ourselves have been found to be sinners,

is Christ [**YES-LORD!**]

then a servant of sin?

Certainly not!

18 But if I build up again the very things that I once tore down,

then I demonstrate that I am a transgressor.

19 For through the law [**SNAP!**]

I died to the law [**SNAP!**],

so that I might live [**OH-YEAH!**]

to God.

I have been crucified with Christ [**YES-LORD!**];

20 and it is no longer I who live [**OH-YEAH!**],

but it is Christ [**YES-LORD!**]

who lives [**OH-YEAH!**]

in me.

And the life [**OH-YEAH!**]

I now live [**OH-YEAH!**]

in the flesh I live [**OH-YEAH!**]

by faith [**A-MEN!**]

in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

21 I do not nullify the grace of God;

for if justification [**CLAP!**]

comes through the law [**SNAP!**],

then Christ [**YES-LORD!**]

died for nothing.
