Woe to the shepherds who destroy and scatter [the sheep of my pasture](#)! says the Lord.
 2 Therefore thus says the Lord, the God of Israel, concerning the shepherds who shepherd my people: It is you who have [scattered my flock](#), and have driven them away, and you have not [attended](#) to them. So I will [attend](#) to you for your evil doings, says the Lord. 3 Then I myself will gather the remnant of my flock out of all the lands where I have driven them, and I will bring them back to their fold, and [they shall be fruitful and multiply](#). 4 [I will raise up shepherds over them who will shepherd them](#), and [they shall not fear any longer, or be dismayed](#), nor shall any be missing, says the Lord. 5 The days are surely coming, says the Lord, when I will raise up for David [a righteous Branch](#), and he shall reign as king and [deal wisely](#), and shall execute justice and righteousness in the land. 6 In his days Judah will be saved and Israel [will live in safety](#). And this is [the name](#) by which he will be called: “The Lord is our righteousness.”
