

# More Than Hearing Worksheet

Episode: AOrdinary30x2017

Text: Matthew 22:34-46

34 When the Pharisees **heard** that **he had silenced the Sadducees**, they gathered together, 35 and one of them, a lawyer, **asked him a question to test him**. 36 “Teacher, which commandment in the law is the greatest?” 37 He said to him, “**You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind.**” 38 This is the greatest and first commandment. 39 And a second is like it: **‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’** 40 On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.”

41 Now while the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them this question: 42 “What do you think of the Messiah? Whose son is he?” They said to him, “The son of David.” 43 He said to them, **“How is it then** that David by the Spirit calls him Lord, saying, 44 ‘The Lord said to my Lord, “Sit at my right hand, until I put your enemies under your feet”’? 45 If David thus calls him Lord, how can he be his son?” 46 No one was able to give him an answer, nor from that day did anyone dare to ask him any more questions.

You probably know where your heart and mind are. If you need to break into smaller groups, use the shape as a way to gather them.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• REL., ALT.: Give everyone one of the shapes named above here, but with no words on them. During the sermon, have people get into groups that have one of each shape. Have them try to figure out what the shapes mean and how they are related.</li> </ul>
<p>Self - Intrapersonal MWD</p>	<p>Loving both God and neighbor enlarges the boundaries of the self.</p>		<p>Take a balloon and label it “self”. Show everyone the “self” balloon.</p> <p>Then take a box of baking soda that has been labeled “neighbor” and pour some into the balloon. Talk about the things you may have in common with your neighbor and the things that are different. Be sure to mention that God has made you both.</p> <p>Then take a bottle of vinegar labeled “God” and pour it into the balloon with the baking powder and show how loving both of them expands the self.</p> <p>Be CERTAIN to try this at home first, so you will know how much you will need to clean up afterwards.</p>
