People - Interpersonal	He lets us rule as kings and serve God his Father as priests. (CEV) He has made us a Kingdom of priests for God his Father. (NLT)	Both kingship and priesthood are somewhat foreign to American audiences. Christ is here said to be ruler of all kings and that he allows us to serve as kings. What are the purposes, goals, and results of kings? What characteristics ought they to demonstrate? [to make wise decisions on the use of power and authority for the wellbeing of one's subjects; to be fair, just, wise, compassionate, cooperative, strong, good] How do you do at that? Similarly for priests, what is their job? [to intercede between God and people, carrying the people into God's presence, conveying the will / presence / challenge / love of God to people] How are you doing at that?	Either make, acquire, or provide for the making of crowns for all in worship, so they may remember to act as kings for Christ. Similarly provide ephods - a breastplate, perhaps with a string or yarn to wear around the neck so they remember to act as priests. (Note that Christ is ruler of all kings, and we are then a kingdom of priests, so Christ is our ruler - duh)
