A Call to Worship and Obedience

- 1 O come, **let us sing** to the Lord;
let us make **a joyful noise** to the **rock** of our salvation!
- 2 Let us **come into his presence** with thanksgiving;
let us make a joyful noise to him with songs of praise!
- 3 For the Lord is a great God,
and a great King above all gods.
- 4 In his hand are the **depths of the earth**;
the **heights of the mountains** are his also.
- 5 The sea is his, for he made it,
and the dry land, which his hands have formed.
- 6 O come, let us **worship and bow down**,
let us kneel before the Lord, our Maker!
- 7 For he is our God,
and we are **the people of his pasture**,
and the sheep of his hand.
- O that today you would **listen to his voice!**
- 8 Do not **harden your hearts**, as at Meribah, **harden your hearts**
as on the day at Massah **in the wilderness**,
- 9 when your ancestors tested me,
and **put me to the proof**, **though they had seen my work**.
- 10 For forty years I **loathed that generation**
and said, "They are **a people whose hearts go astray**,
and they do not regard my ways."
- 11 Therefore in my anger I swore,
"They shall not enter my rest."
