## Results of Justification

1 Therefore, since we are **justified** by faith, we have **peace with God** through our Lord Jesus Christ, 2 through whom we have **obtained access** to this grace **in which we stand**; and **we boast in our hope** of sharing the glory of God. 3 And not only that, but **we also boast in our sufferings**, knowing that **suffering produces endurance**, 4 **and endurance produces character**, and **character produces hope**, 5 **and hope does not disappoint us**, because **God's love has been poured into our hearts** through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us.

6 For while **we were still weak**, **at the right time** Christ died for the ungodly. 7 Indeed, rarely will anyone die for a righteous person—though perhaps for a good person someone might actually **dare to die**. 8 But **God proves his love** for us in that while we still were sinners Christ died for us. 9 **Much more surely then**, now that we have been **justified by his blood**, will we be saved through him **from the wrath of God**. 10 For if **while we were enemies**, we were **reconciled** to God through the death of his Son, much more surely, **having been reconciled**, will we be saved by his life. 11 But more than that, we even boast in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now **received reconciliation**.
